What's new with ReEntry?

In the second phase of the ReEntry project, partner organisations have been busy developing content for the Online Catalogue of Best Practice, translating and localizing resources for their local target groups and disseminating the project with relevant groups and individuals on the ground.

Online Catalogue of Best Practice is launched!

The ReEntry project team has spent the last few months researching appropriate government initiatives, training and mentoring programmes and financial incentives and supports for Europe's migrant entrepreneurs. This research has led partner to developing a total of 30 examples of best practice in supporting migrants and refugees across Europe into self-employment. These best practice examples are targeted at career guidance counsellors, job coaches, enterprise support workers, social workers and VET and adult education professionals working with European migrant communities.


The ReEntry project team developed this online library of appropriate best practices to ensure that accurate, relevant and up-to-date information is provided to these target groups which will in-turn improve their service to migrant entrepreneurs in Europe. The information in the online library is written in accessible language, so that it can also be accessed and interpreted directly by migrant entrepreneurs who want to learn more about the type of supports available to them in their host country. For those migrant entrepreneurs with additional questions about the best practice examples profiled on the library, there is also an interactive function on the project website where migrants can post their question in their mother tongue and this is then translated into the language of their host country so that ReEntry project partners can respond to this question.

At present the 30 examples which are presented through the online library are from Ireland, Portugal, Austria, Slovakia, Czech Republic, Slovenia, Italy, Spain, Poland, Hungary and the Netherlands. They are currently being localised, and the most relevant examples are being translated by all partners.

ReEntry Dissemination Events


The ReEntry project was presented at an event in the Secondary Business School in Žilina, Slovakia.
